



## FIRM UPDATE

Cutler first opened its doors in 1977, leasing space in the historic Pacific Mutual Building, (now known as the Pacific Center) 523 W. 6th St. in downtown Los Angeles. The building was constructed of Corinthian architecture in 1908. Mr. Cutler was a true student of history, and always enjoyed reflecting on "the olden days." He was particularly proud of opening our firm in a location with a strong, historic significance.

Thirty years later, Cutler Investment Group is relocating its headquarters to an historic building that originally housed the first public school, District No.1, in the heart of the historic town of Jacksonville, OR. Coincidentally, our "new building" was also constructed in 1908.

In anticipation of this move, the company opened temporary quarters last year in Jacksonville. Following a fall of remodeling, we anticipate occupying the building by the first of the year.
